DRESS CODE

Members, their children and guests should always dress according to the dictates of good taste and in keeping with the character of the Club. Members are reminded that they are responsible for the dress of their children and guests.

IN THE CLUBHOUSE

General

Smart casual dress may be worn at all times, but a jacket, shirt and tie are required for formal occasions and for post Club Match meals.

Not permitted

Stretched, ripped or torn jeans, sleeveless or collarless shirts (except recognised turtle neck golf shirts) outdoor body warmers, anoraks, coats, bomber jackets, track suits, golf shoes (except in Snug Bar), shirts bearing slogans (other than Club, Society or Manufacturer logos)

Shorts below or more than four inches above the knee (except three quarter length tailored trousers are permitted for ladies). Untidy, dirty or wet clothing. Head gear of any kind, except worn for religious reasons.

Note: Clean and smart denim jeans, which are not stretched, ripped or torn, are permitted in the Club House but are not permitted on the Course.

ON THE COURSE

General

Golf shoes must be worn and caps the correct way around. Shorts must be tailored and worn with knee, ankle or liner sports socks and must not be below or more than four inches above the knee. Three quarter length tailored trousers are permitted for ladies.

Not permitted

Denim jeans (of any sort), sleeveless or collarless shirts (except recognised turtle neck golf shirts) track suits, trousers tucked into socks, shirts outside trousers or shorts, shirts bearing slogans (other than Club, Society or Manufacturer logos)
