

## **Guidelines for Visiting Golfers**

(to be read in conjunction with the local rules on the reverse of the card)

1. **Yellow Lines** – define areas where golfers are not allowed to take their trolleys. This protects vulnerable areas and prevents them becoming worn and muddy.
2. **Broken White Lines** – define fairways from the rough in parts of the course where growth is insufficient to define these areas.
3. **White Lines** – define Ground Under Repair (GUR). Players **MUST** take relief from GUR under Rule 25.1.
4. **Trolley Bans** – from time to time it is necessary to apply either an **electric** trolley ban or a **complete** trolley ban. Please check in advance.
5. **Winter Rules** (Preferred Lies) – when in force, any ball lying on the fairway may, without penalty, be marked, lifted, cleaned and placed within 6 inches of where it originally lay, not closer to the hole.
6. **Priority on the Course** – Tavistock Golf Course is located on ‘common land’ and is used by ramblers, riders and members of the public, all of whom have **right of way**. It is also widely used by ponies and other livestock. Please be patient, give way as appropriate and be aware of the potential hazards to third parties. Tavistock Golf Club cannot accept liability in the event of accidents.
7. **Suspension of Play** - if weather or other circumstances dictate, then play will be suspended. This will be indicated by **3 short blasts** (repeated) on a klaxon. Players should mark the position of their ball and await further instructions. Resumption of play will be indicated by a long blast of the klaxon (repeated).
